

SHUTTLE BUSES FOR RELAY TEAMS

If you are running Leg 1 of the Marathon Relay...

Make your way to the full marathon starting line at the Andrews Street Bridge. The relay begins at 7:30 along with the full marathon. You may go to the starting line by foot as your warm up, or arrange to have someone drop you off. The starting line is ½ mile from Frontier Field. Only the person running the **fourth** leg for your team will be wearing a timing chip, so you will not need to pick one up for yourself at Frontier Field.

You will finish your leg at the St. John Fisher College Park and Ride Lot. Every relay point is also a water stop.

You may arrange your own transportation to pick you up from the St. John Fisher College Park and Ride Lot, or you may take one of the following shuttle buses back to Frontier Field:

<u>Pick Up at St. John Fisher Park and Ride</u>	<u>Destination</u>	<u>Arrive Back at Frontier Field</u>
9:00 am	Frontier Field	9:30 am
10:00 am	Frontier Field	10:30 am

If you are running Leg 2 of the Marathon Relay...

You will be starting at the St. John Fisher College Park and Ride Lot. You may arrange your own transportation to this point or take one of the two shuttle buses. Those buses will be picking up only leg two runners and will leave Frontier Field at **7:00 am**. They will arrive at The St. John Fisher College Park and Ride Lot by **7:30 am**. You can meet these buses on the corner of North Plymouth Avenue and Morrie Silver Way. Only the person running the **fourth** leg for your team will be wearing a timing chip, so you will not need to pick one up for yourself at Frontier Field.

You will finish your leg at Burgundy Basin Inn. Every relay point is also a water stop.

You may arrange your own transportation to pick you up from Burgundy Basin Inn, or you may take one of the following shuttle buses back to Frontier Field:

<u>Pick Up at Burgundy Basin Inn</u>	<u>Destination</u>	<u>Arrive Back at Frontier Field</u>
9:30 am	Frontier Field	10:00 am
10:30 am	Frontier Field	11:00 am

If you are running Leg 3 of the Marathon Relay...

You will be starting at Burgundy Basin Inn. You may arrange your own transportation to Burgundy Basin Inn or take one of the two shuttle buses. Those buses will be picking up only leg three runners and will leave Frontier Field at **7:30 am**. They will arrive at Burgundy Basin Inn by **8:00 am**. You can meet these buses on the corner of North Plymouth Avenue and Morrie Silver Way. Only the person running the **fourth** leg for your team will be wearing a timing chip, so you will not need to pick one up for yourself at Frontier Field.

You will finish along the Erie Canal where it meets Clinton Avenue. Every relay point is also a water stop.

You may arrange your own transportation to pick you up from the Canal near Clinton Avenue, or you may take one of the following shuttle buses back to Frontier Field:

<u>Pick Up @ Erie Canal by Clinton Ave</u>	<u>Destination</u>	<u>Arrive Back at Frontier Field</u>
11:00 am	Frontier Field	11:30 am
11:30 am	Frontier Field	12:00 pm
12:30 pm	Frontier Field	1:00 pm

If you are running Leg 4 (final leg) of the Marathon Relay...

You will be starting at the stop where Clinton Avenue meets the Erie Canal. You may arrange your own transportation or take one of the two shuttle buses. Those buses will be picking up only leg four runners and will leave Frontier Field at **8:00 am**. They will arrive at The Clinton Avenue @ Erie Canal stop by **8:30 am**. You can meet these buses on the corner of North Plymouth Avenue and Morrie Silver Way. As the **fourth** leg runner for your team, you will be wearing the only timing chip for your team. That means you must get your chip at Frontier Field before going to your starting relay point.

You will finish at the MVP Health Care Rochester Marathon Finish line at Frontier Field. No additional transportation will be provided.
